PolyCine GmbH is starting a new construction project in Schiffweiler to expand its capacities

In the 2nd quarter of 2020, PolyCine GmbH started construction work for the expansion of the existing company building at the Schiffweiler plant. The completion is planned for 2021. The company cites the strong economic growth in recent years and the initiation of new major projects with international customers as reasons for the structural expansion.

"Our investment plan includes new production facilities and the expansion of our logistics and storage capacities. With the planned expansion of capacities in Schiffweiler, we are making one of the largest investments in our company's history," explains René Groß, the Managing Director of PolyCine GmbH, and makes the scale of the construction project clear.

Founded in 2002, the company now supplies customers in more than 40 countries and sets standards with its products in terms of quality, technical performance and innovation. And the future prognoses of the Saarland global player are also great: The trend to use PVC-free materials will continue in the future and will also be complemented by the trend towards material reduction in packaging.

"Flexible bags, conventional glass or plastic bottles, all pharmaceutical primary packaging systems are one-way / single-use systems," explains PolyCine head of the development Dr. Susanne Holzer. "The ultra thin, sterilizable multilayer plastic films developed by us and manufactured in the cleanrooms in Schiffweiler are therefore much more resource-efficient than corresponding disposable bottles and also offer excellent barrier properties. Of course, it is also possible to reduce the outer packaging / secondary packaging volume," continues the expert.



PolyCine GmbH, located in Schiffweiler in the Saarland, is a world leader in the manufacture of high-quality, polypropylene-based films for pharmaceutical applications. Founded in 2002, the company now supplies customers in more than 40 countries and continues to set standards with its products in terms of quality, technical performance and innovation. The product range includes special films and tubing systems for infusion solutions as well as the high gas barrier films patented by PolyCine for antibiotics and vitamin solutions, peel seam films for multi-chamber bags and flat films for drainage bags and drainage systems.
